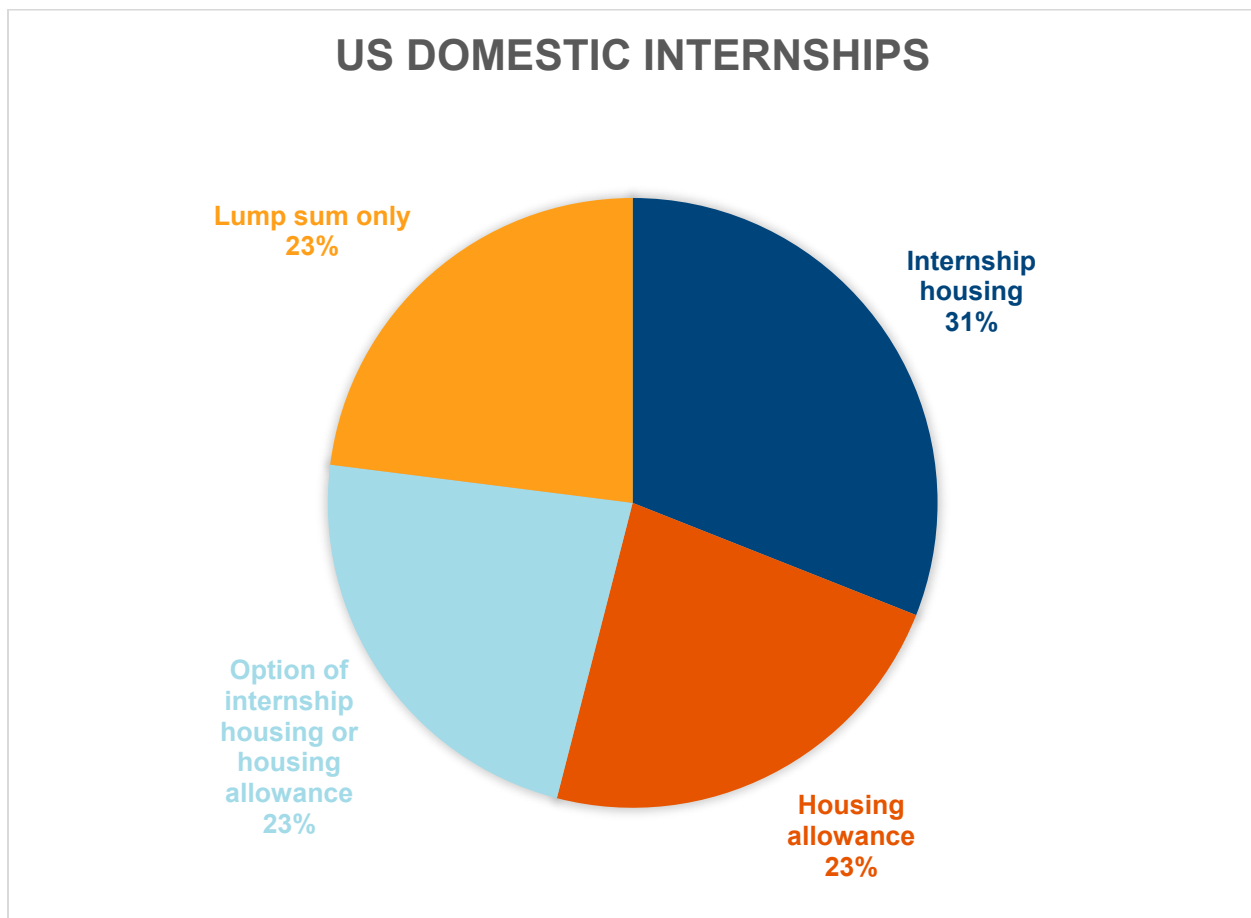


US Domestic Internships

The most common support for US domestic internships is either short-term housing or a one-time lump sum allowance. When housing is provided, companies offer assistance with accommodation arrangements, a housing stipend, or the option between the two types of support.



Aside from housing, other benefits offered to interns include coverage of travel expenses to/from the internship (50%) and a miscellaneous expense allowance (29%). Of those companies that provide an MEA, 75% use a flat-dollar amount ranging from USD 2,500 – USD 4,000 and 25% calculate the amount based on the distance to the internship location.
